Unlocking the learning

Unlocking the learning at home - It is really important that children have the opportunity to use what they learn in school at home. Watch a weather report at home. What information does the weather reporter tell you?

Get reading - Collect some information about the weather or how clouds are formed!

Get exploring - Take a walk to the park. What signs do you see that tell you what season we are in? Take photographs of things you see that tell you spring is coming.

Get creating - Make a collage using natural materials found.

Numeracy. We will be covering...

This half term, the children will be developing their problem solving skills. This will include word problems and using skills that require them to use known number facts to find patterns, sequences and strategies. We will continue to teach number bonds and early times table skills. The children will learn how to solve simple problems using multiplication and division. As part of our topic we shall also be taking measurements of temperatures. To help your child at home, please encourage them to use number as a part of their everyday activities. For example, using money when going shopping. Can they work out how much change they may get when they buy something?

Topic. We will be covering...

In Class CM the children will be focusing on the topic 'Splendid Skies'.

For our topic we will be exploring seasonal changes through science. Creating collages and painting sky scenes. Through geography looking at seasonal and daily weather and how it changes. We shall also look at a significant individual, Sir Francis Beaufort, and what he developed.

Please ensure:

Your child has their PE kit in school - it is important for children to take part in PE for 2 hours every week. If they do not have their PE kit then your child will receive a letter home asking you to provide them with suitable clothing.

Your child reads at home daily - please keep up with the reading at home as it will help develop imagination for writing, underpin Phonics and help with spelling. Reading regularly at home supports children with their writing as well.

Literacy. We will be covering...

During Literacy this half term we will begin to write in different forms such as stories and information. Children will be encouraged to develop their writing skills further by extending descriptions used through use of purposeful adjectives. We shall also be looking at how we can organise our writing using features of text that we have looked at through guided reading.
