Splendid Skies - Creative Homework Projects

Please complete at least ONE of the tasks. Here are some ideas to help you. Please bring to school from 9th March Good Luck!

Fly a kite

Learn how to fly a kite. Maybe you could have a go at making your own. Take pictures of you flying your kite.

Library visit

Visit your local library and find some stories that are about the weather. Bring them to school to share with the class. Which one is your favourite?

Weather chart

Make your own weather chart. Look at the weather report on the television to get some ideas.

Weather walk

Go on weather walk. Collect things that show you what the season is. How do you know it is winter? Spring? What signs is nature giving to show it is almost spring?

Research

Find out about the different types of clouds that there are? What have you learnt? Can you produce a poster?
