Please note that all after school clubs finish the week commencing Monday 5 December.

Wednesday 30 November at 9.30am – Pantomime

The whole school will be treated to an exciting performance of Dick Whittington during the morning. Afternoon nursery children are welcome to attend but must be accompanied by an adult.

Thursday 1 December at 3.30pm– Christmas Workshop (ticketed event)

Our Christmas Workshop takes place again on this day. The children and their parents/carers are invited to this event to make a variety of Christmas decorations.

Please note that each person attending will require a ticket and that we will be unable to admit people who just turn up on the day. We have a set number of seats that must comply with Fire and Health and Safety regulations and we cannot exceed that number. We also request that any pushchairs/prams be left outside the hall rather than being taken inside, again for compliance with fire regulations. First choice tickets will be distributed on Thursday 1 December and any spares will be given out on Monday 5 December.

Monday 12 December at 2.30pm – KS2 Carols for Parents.

Any parents of Years 3 and 4 children are very welcome to join us for a festive singalong.

Tuesday 13 December – School Council Christmas Fayre.

This event is open to children only. As usual, this event will be held in the school hall during the course of the morning. Children will be taken in their classes to the Fayre where they will be able to purchase small, inexpensive gifts/decorations.
