<p><u>Evacuee Diary</u></p> <p>Imagine you are an evacuee. Write a postcard home explaining to your family what has happened to you. Remember to include where you are and what things are different for you.</p>	<p><u>Bombs at home</u></p> <p>Imagine you are alive in the war and your street has been bombed. Write a newspaper report about a bombing in your street. Who could you use as an eye witness quote? What might the damage be?</p>	<p><u>Biography</u></p> <p>Research and write a biography about one of the famous characters from WWII. For example you could choose Winston Churchill or Neville Chamberlain.</p>
<p><u>Rationing</u></p> <p>Find out what food was rationed in the war and perhaps how much the food cost then. You could write some recipes using rationed foods or write a daily menu for a family in the war.</p>	<p><u>Shelter</u></p> <p>What was an air raid shelter? Can you make a model of an air raid shelter or Anderson Shelter using card? What sorts of things went into an air raid shelter?</p>	<p><u>Timeline</u></p> <p>Create a timeline of the main events of WWII. The war lasted 1939-1945 so there were many things happening during the six years you could add to your timeline.</p>
<p><u>Morse code</u></p> <p>Write your name or a secret message in Morse Code. Who could you write your secret message to?</p>	<p><u>It's an Enigma</u></p> <p>Find out what the Enigma machine did and where it was based.</p>	<p><u>The Army needs you</u></p> <p>Write a poster or leaflet to persuade people to join the army. Why did Britain need to recruit more people into the army during that time?</p>
