Writing Project Options 	<u>Special Message</u> Can you create a special message to put in your memory box so you can read it in years to come?	<u>Special Wishes</u> Can you get your family members to write special wishes for you to keep in your memory box so you can read it when you are older? They might want to give advice or a special wish for your future.	<u>Friends List</u> Can you create a special list of all your closest friends and other people who are special to you? You might want to include family pets in the list as well.
Research Project Options 	<u>Names</u> Can you research what your first name and last name means? You could look on the internet and write about what it means.	<u>Information booklet</u> Can you create an information book about your family? You can interview family members and write about their hobbies, favourite food or friends.	<u>Birthday cards</u> Can you research why we send birthday cards and find out when the first birthday card was sent?
Creative Project Options 	<u>Family Tree</u> Can you create a family tree of all your closest family members? You might want to use photos or drawings of the people.	<u>Collage</u> Can you create a collage of photos of you throughout your life? You could start with a baby photo in the middle.	<u>Portrait</u> Can you paint a family portrait of your own family? You could paint it from an old family photo or get your family members to pose for you!
