Being on time for Nursery

Morning sessions – 8.40-11.40

Afternoon session – 12.30-3.30

We fit a lot of learning into our Nursery sessions and this starts from the moment the children arrive.

When children arrive late they can miss key aspects of the session, such as the introduction to learning, which may mean they are unable to fully access learning opportunities available. It can also be distracting for the children who are already engaged in learning activities to have children arriving late, as it takes staff away from them in order to support the late children in accessing the Nursery routines and the learning available.

We do appreciate that at times unforeseen circumstances may mean that you are unable to be on time for a session but in order to support all the children be on time as often as you can.

The importance of being on time ~

- Allows your child to follow the Nursery routines and develop their independence
- Helps your children to develop and build relationships within the Nursery
 - Gives your child time to settle and get ready for learning activities
 - Sets up positive habits for their school life and also their future life
