
Races/competitions start at 9.15am for approximately 1 hour

- Children will need their PE kit in school, please also remember hats and sunscreen.
- A separate epraise message has been sent out to Nursery parents, regarding children that do not normally attend Nursery on a Wednesday.

Year 3 and Year 4 in September

After much discussion, we have made the decision to redistribute children in some of the current classes to create new classes for September. This will happen for the children who are currently in Year 2 and Year 3.

Class 2F and Class 2FB will be redistributed to create 2 new Year 3 classes. Class 3B and Class 3S will be redistributed to create 2 new Year 4 classes.

The reason for this change is that the current classes are not well balanced socially, academically and in terms of children requiring additional support. When schools have two parallel and balanced classes, teachers can plan better together for the majority of the children and then make adaptations to meet individual children's needs. It is most effective for teachers to work together in this way. Some schools shuffle classes each year to get this balance right.

We know that this decision may cause some anxiety for both children and parents/carers and we have worked hard to get the new classes right. The children's current teachers, who know them best, have been fully involved with the new class allocations.

The children in these year groups have found out who is in their class and met their new class teachers and teaching assistants today.


