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Unlocking the Learning

Our topic for this half term is Roman Britain, a History based topic looking at what life was like in Britain when the Romans invaded and the legacy they left behind.

We look forward to seeing the results and would like the children to bring in, or email, their completed projects to us by Friday 7th February, so that they can share and celebrate each other's talents before the end of term. We would ask that this project reflects six weeks' worth of work, and demonstrates the children's own work, although we really appreciate your support in helping them complete their homework.

We believe it is very important that every child has the opportunity to engage with learning at home and will support however we can with this.

Write a factfile or information about them.</p>	<p><u>A Roman Town</u></p> <p>Design your own Roman town. Look at some pictures of the typical layout of a Roman town and use it to create your own.</p>
<p><u>Hadrian's Wall</u></p> <p>Plot Hadrian's Wall on a map of Britain showing where it starts, ends and some of the places it goes through.</p>	<p><u>Online projects</u></p> <p>Research Roman life using books from your local library. Which were the most useful? Recommend the best one to your classmates.</p>	<p><u>Roman Villa</u></p> <p>Create a Roman Villa out of junk materials such as cereal boxes. Use online images and pictures in non-fiction books to inspire the layout of your villa.</p>	<p><u>Roman Tools</u></p> <p>Find out about the tools the Romans used and make a model of one using something like salt dough or clay. Explain what it is and what it was used for.</p>

As scientists we will be learning about soils. We will explore soils and what they are made of. Then we will look at the importance of soil in our world. We will carry out an experiment involving soils.

As historians we will be learning about the Romans and their lasting impact on our way of life. We will find out why the Romans invaded Britain and settled here.

Using our computing skills we will be programming and learning about events and actions. We will begin by moving a sprite in four directions (up, down, left and right). We will then explore movement within the context of a maze, using design to choose an appropriately sized sprite.

In PE we will be developing our dance skills. We will learn to use improvisation, link and combine movements and perform with expression.

As writers we will be developing our writing in a number of styles. We will be using a range of adjectives, fronted adverbials and learning the rules of speech.

Year 3 Spring 1 The Romans

As readers we will be reading The Tin Forest and extracts from The Iron Man. As individual readers, we will focus on developing fluency and intonation through reading with an adult using modelling and paired reading.

Important information
PE is on Wednesday and Fridays. Please ensure your child brings in their full PE kit each week. Lessons will be outdoors where possible, so please ensure your child is dressed appropriately.

As mathematicians, we will be further developing our understanding of multiplication and division by 10, dividing 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, and in some cases through exchanging. We will also focus on the ways we measure, the units we measure in, and how to apply this

In Music we will be composing pieces of our own music using our imagination. and 3S will continue their ukulele lessons on Fridays.

As designers we will be creating bendy bags through our use of textiles. We will design make and evaluate a bag with as few closing mechanism.

In PSHE we will be focusing on our jigsaw topic: Dreams and Goals. We will be thinking about aspirations, how to achieve goals and understanding the emotions that go with this.

In RE we will look at the creation story and what it teaches us. We will find out how Christian beliefs are relayed.
